Plan enough time to explore nature



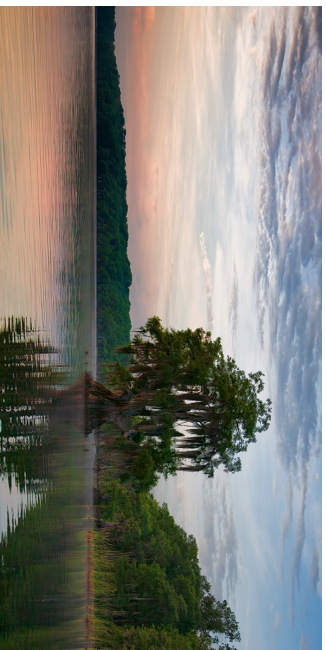
Protect yourself from sun with a hat and sunscreen

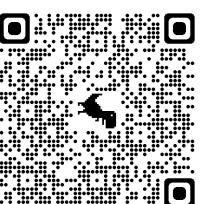
CCI INITIATIVES

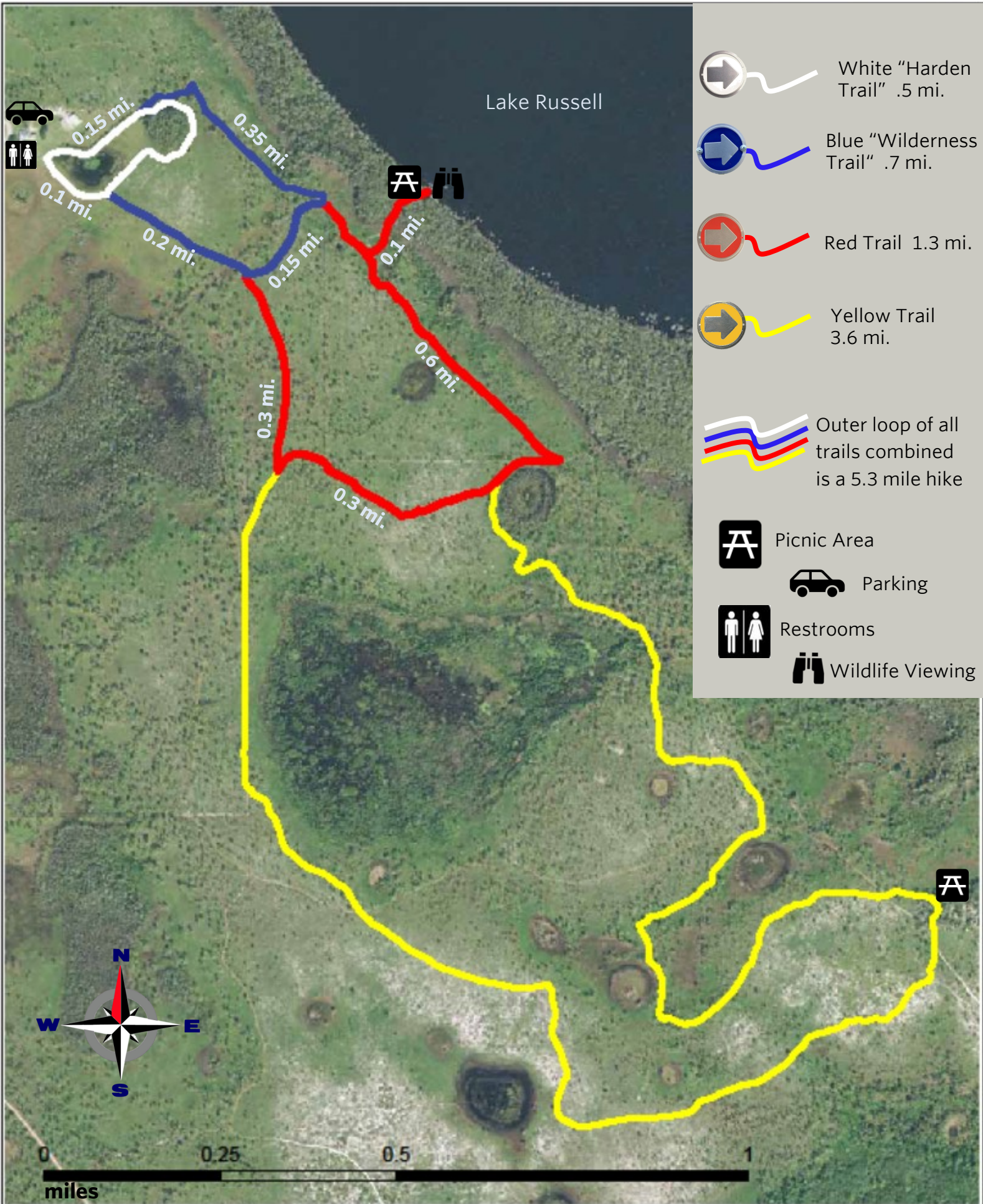
